SAFETY ARTICLE

If you are a first responder or have taken a first aid course you learned the A,B,C's of first aid. They are;

AIRWAY- are there obstructions to breathing? Don't change the victim's head position unless it's absolutely necessary, but open the victim's mouth to check and clear their airway of any foreign material.

BREATHING- is the victim spontaneously breathing with regular, unlabored breaths?

CIRCULATION- check for a pulse at the neck or wrist (don't use your thumb) and count the number of pulses per minute. Use your own pulse as a reference to assess the victim's pulse quality.

As I reviewed this information in the Fall Issue of Iron Butt Magazine I found an addition to the traditional A,B,C's. it is now A,B,C,C-911. Apparently people responding to an emergency forget to call 911 until after they have begun first aid. Please call 911 right away, if there are several people on the scene direct someone to call, professionals come properly equipped to handle the situation.

You can add to your preparation by carrying your own first aid kit. It doesn't have to be very large. A basic kit should include a pair several pairs of latex free gloves. This protects both you and the victim. I've also used these to keep my hands clean if I have to work on the bike on the side of the road. A pair of scissors designed specifically to cut cloth. No sharp tips, but rounded. Remember common sense items, adhesive bandages, a triangular bandage (this has many usages) hand sanitizer, antibiotic ointment packets, antiseptic wipes, chemical cold compresses. Add to that gauze rolls, bandage pads, tape and tweezers.

With this information you can help an injured rider until the professionals arrive on the scene.

The warm, make that hot, weather is upon us. Please remember to stay hydrated in fact a bottle of water or 2 plus a snack in your saddle bag is a good idea. You never know when it will come in handy for you or a friend.

Now get out there and ride but please ride safe and remember PLP is taking July and August off, we will pick back up in September or October, keep your eye on the web site for more information on PLP..
