SAFETY OFFICER: JOHN DEVITO SAFETY ARTICLE

I was on the road nearing the end of an interstate ride when it began to rain. As the road is slipperiest at the beginning of a new rain I pulled into a gas station to top off my tank and have a bottle of water. I waited about 10 minuets for the oil and dirt to wash of the road prior to continuing on with my ride

I pulled out behind a group of riders, approximately 10, heading the same direction I was going. I took up a place in the back of the pack. They were riding single file in the center of the road. If you have attended any MSF class you know a motorcyclist divides a lane into 3 positions, left, center and the right. Which one is the best? That depends on the situation but remember you should place yourself in a position that you can see and be seen. However, on a wet road the center in the slickest part of the road, cars and other 4 wheeled vehicles drop oil and other fluid in the middle. A staggered formation would have been a smarter and safer decision in this case

Several of these riders had their electronic cruise control activated. At the beginning of a rainfall you should turn off your cruise control in your auto or on your motorcycle. Cruise control is designed to maintain your speed. Puddles cause your vehicle to slow, in an effort to maintain your speed the drive wheel will speed up. While riding on a cushion of water the drive wheel will slip spinning faster than necessary. When traction is regained you could spin out of control. This is one of the many causes of interstate crashes in the rain. The loss of control is worse if you are on 2 wheels. How did I know they were using their cruise? Their right hand was wiping visors but not on their throttle. For you smart asses (you know who you are) there were no old police Indian motorcycles in the group with left hand throttles

They continued straight as I turned east to my destination. No incidents occurred while I rode with this group. They most likely wondered who the guy in the back on the white Harley was and why he rode left of center.

One more wet road tip. In a driving rain place your bike in the tire track of the vehicle in front of you. You should see their tire pushing the water to the side and it will keep you out of the center. Your motorcycle tires have a better chance of keeping on the pavement. This will reduce the chances of hydroplaning

Now get out there and ride but please ride safe and this time of the year carry your rain gear

Crash We Witnessed

Most of you know my post retirement career is an MSF rider coach. I'm a fan of "All The Gear All The Time" (ATGATT). In addition I feel all riders should work on their riding skills. With that in mind Diane and I went to Long Island late September and early October. We were west bound on Nesconsit Highway behind a rider on a Streetglide, he looked about my age. As he entered a long left turn lane his speed was 35 to 40 MPH. He was in the blind spot of the car on his right. You guessed it the vehicle began to move toward the motorcycle. They never hit but the rider turned his handlebars left making his M/C move to its right. He panicked and locked up his brakes. Locking the front brake when the bars are not square will cause you to go down as he did. The rider high sided and was thrown from the bike into the guard rail. The bike landed in front of him under the guard rail. His front tire left around 30 feet of skid marks.

Diane was driving our car she stopped turned on her 4 way flashers. I began first aid Diane shut off the downed bike and called 911. The rider had on fingerless gloves and a novelty helmet. As you might have expected he was unconscious and his hands were torn up.

Police and fire rescue responded and the crash was handled as expected. The rider was still out cold when he was placed into the ambulance. The driver that pulled into his lane fled the scene, no big surprise there.

There are several things that would have prevented this crash and reduced injury. First he should have removed himself from the cars blind spot. At the speed the rider was going he should have pressed on the left handle grip the bike would have gone left. If the handlebars were square when the front brake was applied he shouldn't have gone down. A good helmet and gloves would have reduced if not eliminate the injuries.

It was hard to watch a motorcycle crash unfold in front of us however we did what we were trained by our sons to do. I think they would have given us their stamp of approval.


- Attend a Road Captain Training course at least every 2 two years.

- Be a current member of National H.O.G.


- Ride a Harley-Davidson motorcycle


