

SAFETY OFFICER: JOHN DEVITO SAFETY ARTICLE

What a good year 2015 has been, our chapter has accomplished a lot. With the Christmas Party, Decembers PLP and several rides yet to come there is more to do.

In November our Parking Lot Practice (PLP) had a small turn out, about 18 members. These riders all wanted to work on their riding skills. With their enthusiasm we did get a lot done. No, we didn't teach them anything new however we reminded the riders of things they had had forgotten.

Every now and then we have to remind riders, during slow tight maneuvers you need to keep the RPM's high and use the friction zone. To you mature riders that means slip the clutch. Yes you can lug the engine on big V-Twins but not when leaned over in a slow tight turn. With the rev's high and the clutch in the friction zone, should you feel the bike start to go over you just let the clutch out and your bike will stand up.

Again if your bike is equipped with engine and saddle bag guards and it is on the way down keep your feet on the floor boards or foot pegs and let it drop. Don't try to stop it with your foot or arm, you could break something during the fall. As we like to say we are not teaching the mature (make that old) rider something new but reminding them of something they forgot. Is there something you want to work on? Is there some riding skill you need to improve? This information has been covered in prior articles. Its being repeated as our chapter has new members (and old) that may find this information helpful. Come on out and let us know, we will be there to assist.

Now to my favorite topic the Drill Team, why is that my favorite topic you ask? Team members practice riding once a week and continue to improve their riding abilities. There have been several retirements on the team and we no longer have enough to perform a drill. In fact this is the first time in my 16 years with the team we will not be in any Christmas Parades.

The team will now have practice every Sunday at 10:00 a.m. next to the pavilion at Destination. The team would like any rider interested to come out and work with them. There are things team members learn that we do not cover at a PLP. For additional information please contact Roger White.




