LEAVING THE GROUP by Mitch Powell Safety Officer

Occasionally on a club ride, a member of the group will pull out of formation.

This can be a distraction leading to confusion and sudden braking and could compromise the safety of the group.

If you must pull out of line unexpectedly and if there is time, try to signal to those around you that first you are slowing down and second that you are about to make a maneuver away from the group.

If you are just leaving with no problems and don't give a big thumbs up signal, the rear captain will still stop to render assistance. This leaves the group moving ahead unnecessarily without a sweep, a less safe situation.

A much safer scenario would be to inform the lead road captain in advance of the ride briefing that you intend to leave the ride at a specified point.

You can be positioned at the end of the group before the rear captain.

This is a much safer position for a scheduled exit maneuver and doesn't affect the positions of the staggered group. When a mid-positioned rider leaves a staggered formation, it results in an open position.

According to the Motorcycle Safety Foundation, it is recommended that each member should move diagonally across the lane to make up the stagger. This recommendation takes into consideration that in many states, lane sharing (riding side by side) is legal, but overtaking and passing a vehicle in the same lane is not legal. This is the case in Florida.

Remember **riding side by side leaves** you a smaller space cushion in which to maneuver if you need to swerve to avoid a hazard and risks handlebar entanglement. **Thus, it is not considered the safest practice**. Our Daytona HOG Chapter recommends filling the open position when the group comes to a stop, where we can tighten up the formation, filling the void safely before pulling away.
