From Berlin, Germany

On February 21, 2018 a German newspaper reports that the European Union [EU] is drawing up a list of U.S. products to target - including orange juice and Kentucky bourbon – IF Washington restricts imports of aluminum and steel.

The U.S. Commerce Department last week urged President Donald Trump to impose Tariffs OR quotas on foreign made metals, citing national security concerns.




