



Message from the Safety Director

Safety Article - HOG February Newsletter

Food for Thought!!

As a university professor, I tend to be research and data driven. Recently the National Highway Traffic Administration (NHTSA) published the latest (2018) data on motorcycle helmet use and fatalities.

- Helmet use on roads increased from 55% in 2017 to 70.1% in 2018.
- Helmet use among motorcyclists when riding with a passenger increased from 51.3% in 2017 to 73.8% in 2018.
- Motorcyclists make up 3% of all registered vehicles in the United State in 2018 and yet accounts for only 0.6% of all on-road vehicle miles traveled.
- Per registered vehicles, the fatality rate for motorcyclists in 2018 was 6 times that for passenger car occupants.
- Per vehicle mile traveled in 2018, motorcyclist fatalities occurred greater than 27 times more frequently than passenger car occupant fatalities.

I am certainly not intending to be a downer or preach to you; however, the above data should reinforce the need to maintain our operational skills and wear proper protective gear when riding. But even all the protective gear will do little if we fail to be ever vigilant when out on the road. Anticipating that most cagers will fail to see us on our motorcycles, and always having an escape route will help to keep you from being a negative statistic.

Ride safe!

Tire Failure

A HOG member's personal experience

Most people who ride any distance prepare for a flat tire. They carry a 12 V-DC compressor, a tire plug kit or some just carry a can of fix a flat. Good to have when you walk out of your motel room to find your motorcycle with a flat tire. If you get a flat while riding would you know what it felt like or what to do? The motorcycle feels like it's hinged in the middle. The faster you are moving the more violent the shake becomes. It almost feels as if the back tire is trying to catch up to the front wheel.

The first time this happened to me was 40 years or so ago. I was on my Ironhead Sportster. I slowed down, stood up and leaned over the front wheel, in an attempt to take the weight off the rear wheel. It worked and I was able to ride home just a few miles away.

This past week I rode home from PLP and it happened again. I was on my Softail, traveling west on I-4, doing the speed limit in the right lane. I felt the back tire going soft. I followed protocol turning off my control off to reduce my speed. I could not lean over the front end due to the windshield. It is a heaver bike than the Ironhead. I pressed on the right-hand grip, in an effort to move off the interstate on to the shoulder. As I did the tire rolled off the rim. It would not respond to any steering inputs, in fact it pulled left across 3 lanes. I took a quick look in my mirror fortunately there was no traffic behind me.

The median is wide at this point, lower in the center. When I hit the wet grass, my speed scrubbed off quickly. As I slowed, I pressed on the right-hand grip laying the bike down gently in the grass. I was ok and took a minute to evaluate the situation. I tried to move the bike but was unable. Inspection showed the tire was jammed between the rim, fender, and swing arm.

Fast forward to the wrecker arriving. The only way to get the bike on the flat bed was to drag it up with the winch. Once home I needed the winch on my Jeep to get it off the flat bed.

My plan is to get it up on my lift and check for any additional damage. I will replace the rim as I am sure its damaged. Two new tires are on my list.

I will miss the civilian skills competition and it will not be ready for Bike Week 2021. That is not a problem, I still have the 1978 Ironhead and it runs well. (yes, I also have a scooter but...).

What saved my butt? My 16 years as an MSF rider coach, working weekly on the Basic, Advanced, Experience, Ultimate Bike Bonding and the 3 Wheel classes. I also believe the grace of God, remember there was no traffic on I-4 when I crossed 3 lanes of I-4. What can you do? Attend PLP or take an Experienced Riders Class. Also remember, All The Gear All The Time, ATGATT.








The 'RIDE 365' Program

RIDE 365

For the year 2021, qualifying H.O.G. members now earn one point on their <u>Harley-Davidson VISA card</u> for every mile you ride on your H-D Motorcycle, up to 50,000 miles in a calendar year. That is up to \$500 in H-D Gift Cards from the Motor Company!

How will my mileage be tracked?

You must have your odometer mileage validated at your H-D Dealership at the beginning of the calendar year. After that, you can return to the dealership throughout the year to add to your total annual mileage.

Can I enter mileage myself?

To maintain the integrity of the program, mileage must be read and entered at an authorized Harley-Davidson Dealership.

Can H.O.G.® members start the program at any time during the year?

Yes. You may check-in your mileage at any time during the year. The annual program recognizes miles ridden from January 1 through December 31, so it's smart to check-in mileage at the beginning of the year.

How many times each year do H.O.G.® members have to check-in their mileage?

You need only to have your odometer checked in two times each year at the dealership – the first time to validate miles on or after January 1, and the second time is for a final annual total on or before December 31.


However, you'll want to check in with your dealership frequently to enter your updated miles so you can earn digital badges and add to your annual and chapter totals throughout the year. Adding your mileage will instantly update the **H-D.com**/hog website and your chapter totals.

Harley-Davidson Roars Past Wall Street's Earnings Forecast

Harley-Davidson blew past Wall Street's third-quarter earnings expectations Tuesday as the iconic motorcycle maker overhauls its business model. Shares of the Milwaukee-based company were rising 9.9% to \$31.87 in premarket trading.

Harley-Davidson reported earnings of \$120.2 million, or 78 cents a share, compared with \$86.6 million, or 55 cents, a year ago. Adjusted earnings came to \$1.05 a share, well ahead of FactSet's call for 28 cents.

Revenue totaled \$1.16 billion, down from \$1.27 billion, but beat analyst's estimates of \$844 million. Global retail motorcycle sales in the third quarter of 2020 were down 8% from a year ago, Harley-Davidson said, reflecting, among other things, USthe company's shift in timing of the launch of new model year motorcycles from August each year to early first quarter to better align with seasonality.

Harley-Davison plans to concentrate on about 50 markets, primarily in North America, Europe and parts of Asia Pacific, that represent a high percentage of the company's expected volume and growth potential. Harley-Davidson said it has progressed on its makeover plan, dubbed "The Rewire." The new operating model eliminated duplication and complexity across global operations, resulting in "significant expected ongoing SG&A savings," the company said.

Part of the plan includes refreshing the leadership structure, Harley-Davidson said, with most of the leaders being new to their roles. "We have driven significant progress across each key element of *The Rewire* playbook, and we believe the positive changes we have executed are setting our course for a winning future," Jochen Zeitz, chairman, president and CEO, who took over the top position in February, said in a statement.
